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OVERVIEW

Pepsi[®] Major League Baseball[®] PITCH, HIT & RUN™ provides youngsters across the country an opportunity to participate in an exciting baseball skills competition. This national initiative gives boys and girls, ages 7-14, the chance to showcase their pitching, hitting and running abilities.

All of the events are individually scored and converted to a total point score through the use of conversion tables. Boys and girls compete together at all levels of competition.

Each participant will compete in each of the three components of PITCH, HIT & RUN™, and accumulate a total score based on his/her performance.

LEVELS OF COMPETITION

PITCH, HIT & RUN™ is a national grassroots program that has four levels of competition - Local, Sectional, Team Championship and National Finals.

The first level is of a LOCAL scope. Everyone must participate in a local competition in order to advance to the higher levels. Champions at the local level advance to the SECTIONAL Competitions. At this level, the Sectional 1st Place All-Around Champions qualify to advance to the TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS, which are held during June in all 30 Major League Baseball® markets.
